#### Overall Job Purpose:

Assist the Department Leader in raising Biology and Science standards across the school.

- 3. Responsible for curriculum planning for Wales and collaboration
- 4. Pastoral needs of a court / household or corresponding daily and weekly responsibility
- 5. Assist the Department leader on Standards, Learning and Teaching issues and Quality of the Learning Area
- 6. Serve as a member of the School Leadership Team, with opportunities to develop professionally and pathfinder using global school improvement programs

Plan and teach lessons to the assigned classes and teach in the context of school plans, curriculum and work plans.
